

Combi-Ticket NS-RET - 2019

Valid for a single journey in busses, trams and metro operated by RET and in trains operated by NS (2nd class).

Target group:

For travellers who want to make a single journey with both RET and NS.

The Combi-Ticket NS-RET will be sold to Stena Line passengers, who want to travel by public transport in the Netherlands from/to Hoek van Holland Haven where the terminal of Stena Line is located.

Characteristics and validity:

- The Combi-Ticket NS-RET is a disposable single-use smart card with a special travel product valid for a single journey with NS (2nd class) trains from/to every NS-station in the Netherlands and with all busses, trams and metro from the RET.
- Checking in and out: hold your ticket up to the validator or gate to check in before your train, bus, tram or metro journey. Repeat the process to check out when you reach your destination. You need to check in and out with each operator when changing operators or between trains, busses, trams or metro.
- With the ticket you can travel during 2 hours after the first check-in in the busses, STOPenGO, trams and metro operated by RET. Transfer is allowed. Not valid on nightbusses (BOB-bus).
- With the ticket you can make a single journey with NS (2nd class) between 2 stations in the Netherlands. Transfer is allowed. Supplements are required on Intercity Direct and ICE trains. Not valid in Thalys, Eurostar or trains operated by Arriva, Breng, Connexion and Syntus.
- The Combi-Ticket NS-RET is valid from the beginning until the end of the timetable of the concerning public travel operator. A day begins at 00:00 AM and ends the next day at 04:00 AM.

- On board Stena Line vessels
- As a part of a Stena Line package deal
